



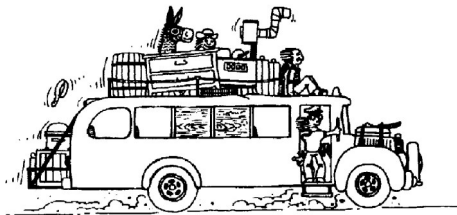
Dart Vader ?

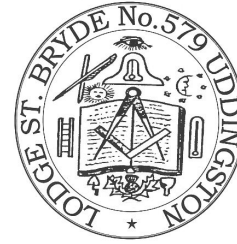
