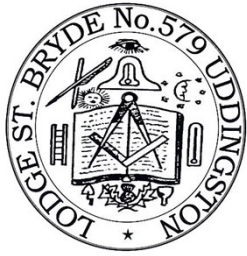
LODGE OPHIRTON

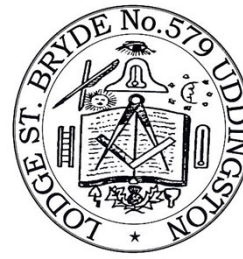
