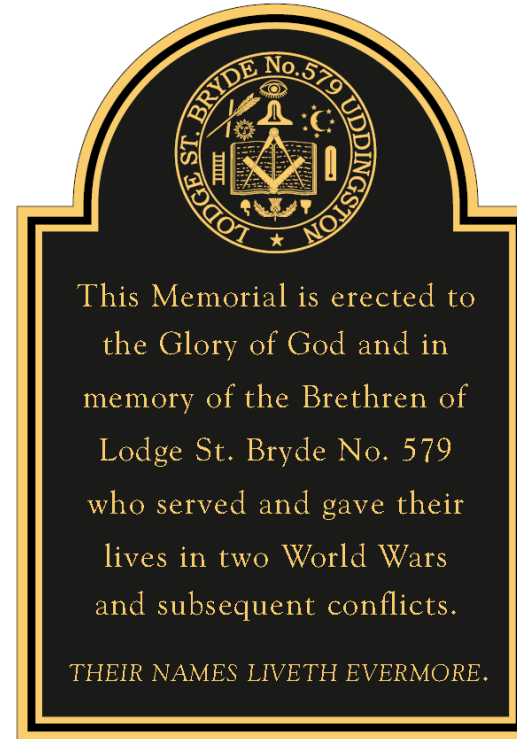

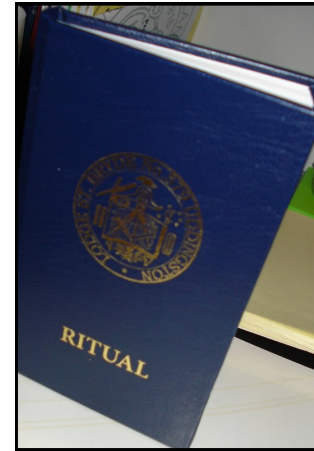
Both Brethren have been very supportive of Lodge Garrowhill and were worthy of the Honour.
