



# <u>Visit to The Sovereign Grand Lodge</u> of Malta.

The Sovereign Grand Lodge of Malta is a relatively new Grand Lodge it was formally founded in November 2004 by the Grand Lodge of Scotland, The Grand Lodge of Ireland and The United Grand Lodge of England. But Freemasonry in Malta dates back

much further in time. In 1741 a Lodge was established

under the French
Marseilles Constitution
although at this time the
Catholic Inquisition took
an interest in the Lodge.
Regular Freemasonry
was imported into Malta
via the presence of
foreign military personnel.
The Occupation by
Napoleonic France 17981800, following this period



and the end of French occupation a documented French prisoner of war Lodge was formed under an English Warrant! English masons continued to grow in numbers and an English District was formed in 1920. One Scottish Lodge is present on the island, St. Andrew No. 966

founded in 1906.
With the withdrawal of British Forces, Freemasonry declined, but in 2003, three Irish Lodges resolved to form the Sovereign Grand Lodge of Malta. The Grand Lodge is growing, and now numbers around eighteen Lodges. The Masonic Hall, which is used by the English and Malta Grand Lodges is well worth a

visit.
